THE FIRST INTERNATIONAL MEETING OF WRITERS IN SOFIA was held on June 7, 8 and 9, 1977. JEAN HERVE BAZIN (France) was Honorary Chairman. 156 writers from 36 countries participated in the meeting.

THE SECOND INTERNATIONAL MEETING OF WRITERS IN SOFIA was held on June 7 and 8, 1979. RAFAEL ALBERTI (Spain) was Honorary Chairman. 69 writers from 22 countries participated in the meeting.

THE THIRD INTERNATIONAL MEETING OF WRITERS IN SOFIA was held on September 29 and 30, 1980. MIGUEL OTTERO SILVA (Venezuela) was Honorary Chairman. 120 writers from 46 countries participated in the meeting.

THE FOURTH INTERNATIONAL MEETING OF WRITERS IN SOFIA was held on September 29 and 30, and on October 1, 1982. JAMES ALDRIDGE (Great Britain) was Honorary Chairman. 151 writers from 56 countries participated in the meeting.

THE FIFTH INTERNATIONAL MEETING OF WRITERS IN SOFIA was held on October 23, 24 and 25, 1984. ERSKINE CALDWELL (USA) was Honorary Chairman. 172 writers from 53 countries participated in the meeting.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The People's Republic of Bulgaria is situated between 41^o and 44^o northern latitude and between 23^o and 29^o eastern longitude.

The Bulgarian state was founded in 681. Christianity was adopted between the years 863 and 870. Since 855 Bulgaria has had its own alphabet and literature.

Today Bulgaria has a population of 8,948,388 and covers an area of 110,911 sq km. Its capital Sofia has a population of 1,200,000. National Holiday – September 9, – the day of the victory of the socialist revolution.
