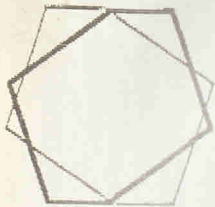

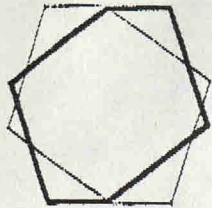
I look forward to the possibility of future cooperation between our two institutions of higher learning.
