In these days that the maintenance of a just, stable peace in Cyprus and a softening between societies is becoming vital, and the creation of the conditions for the establishment of a United People's front against Imperialism is essential, we, as the Progressive Youth of Cyprus, want to do our share of the duty. As a part of the Cypriot youth, we also want to join the Parliament with our young Greek brothers. Due to this, we wish to be with you in the delegation of the young Cypriots that will go to Sofia. We would like to know whether it is possible for us to take part in the same delegation. If so, could you please inform us about it?

One other problem is this: A while ago, there has been a call from the Greek Cypriot artists and poets to their Turkish colleagues with the intention of a mutual meeting. We wish that this meeting would be held among the artists and poet delegates who will go to the Parliament with the other delegations.

We thought that it would be wise to let you know our opinions and wishes on these subjects and we felt the need to ask your advice. We shall be very happy if you would enlighten us on these subjects.

We send our best regards to you, to your wife and to our brothers who fight for a just, stable peace in Cyprus and to EDON.

We would like to thank you for the trouble you will take for the prevention of the reactionary DENKTAŞ policy to make this a subject of speculation.
