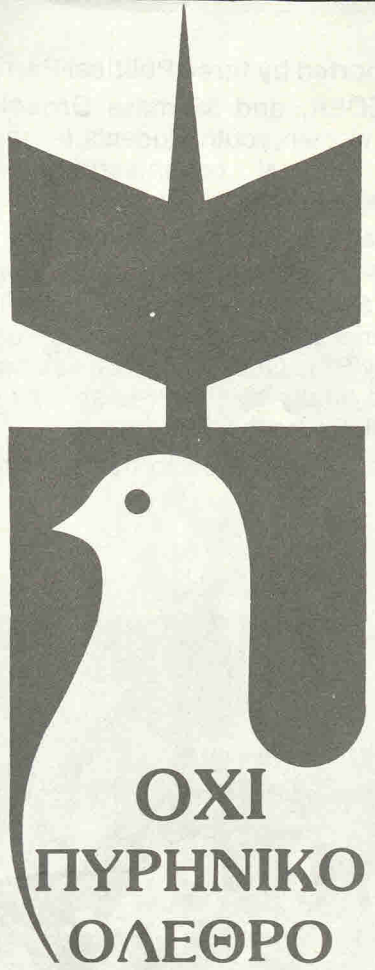

In the world-wide wave of mass manifestations against the danger of a nuclear holocaust, for peace and life on our planet, the people of Cyprus have their contribution too.

Only a few days before the opening of Prague's World Assembly For Peace And Life and as a culmination of the manyfold manifestations of the people of Cyprus for peace, a PEACE MARCH was held on Sunday 12 June 1983.

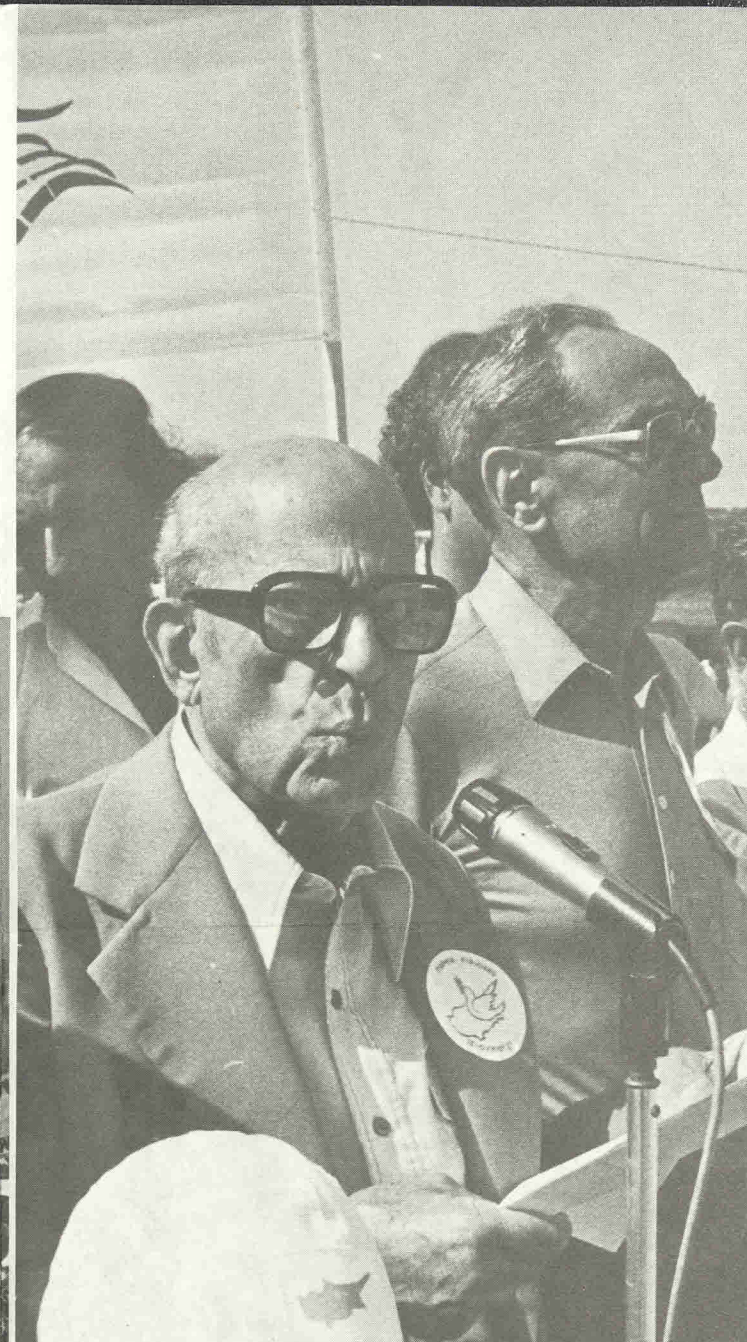
This was the third March organised by the Cyprus Peace Council.

The March started after a mass rally at Acrotiri near the Military Airport of the "British Sovereign Bases" and after covering a distance of 17 kilometres it culminated in an even bigger mass rally at the Municipal Park of Limassol.

The March was supported by three Political Parties: AKEL, DIKO and EDEK, and 30 mass Organisations of workers, peasants, women, youth, students, teachers, refugee committees, cultural organisations etc, representing the vast majority of the Cyprus people.

The marchers were addressed by the following:-
Yiangos Potamitis, President of the Cyprus Peace Council, the Italian Senator, ex-General of NATO, Nino Pasti, the General Secretary of the Peace Committee of Turkey Enis Coskun, the Greek actor Manos Katrakis, and finally by the President of the World Peace Council, Romesh Chandra.

The rally adopted a resolution to the Secretary General of UNO.

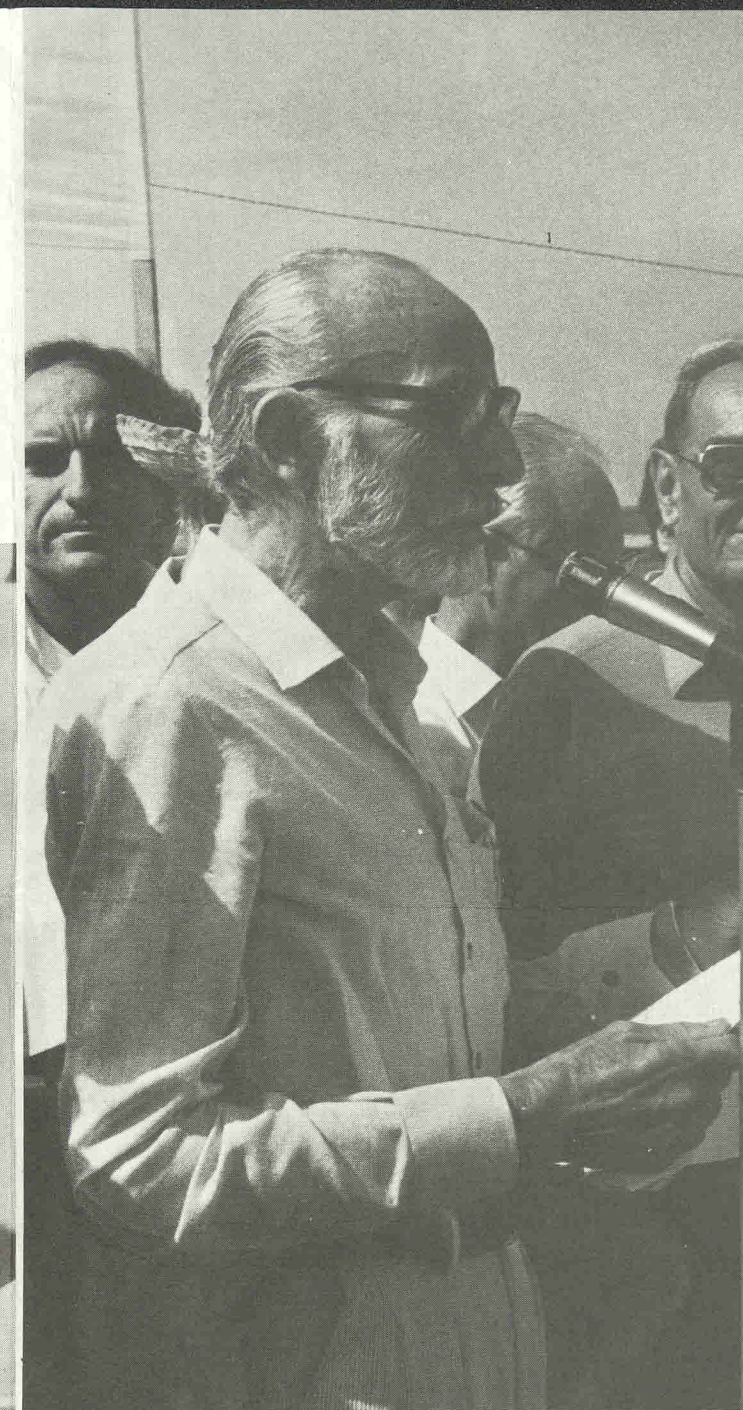
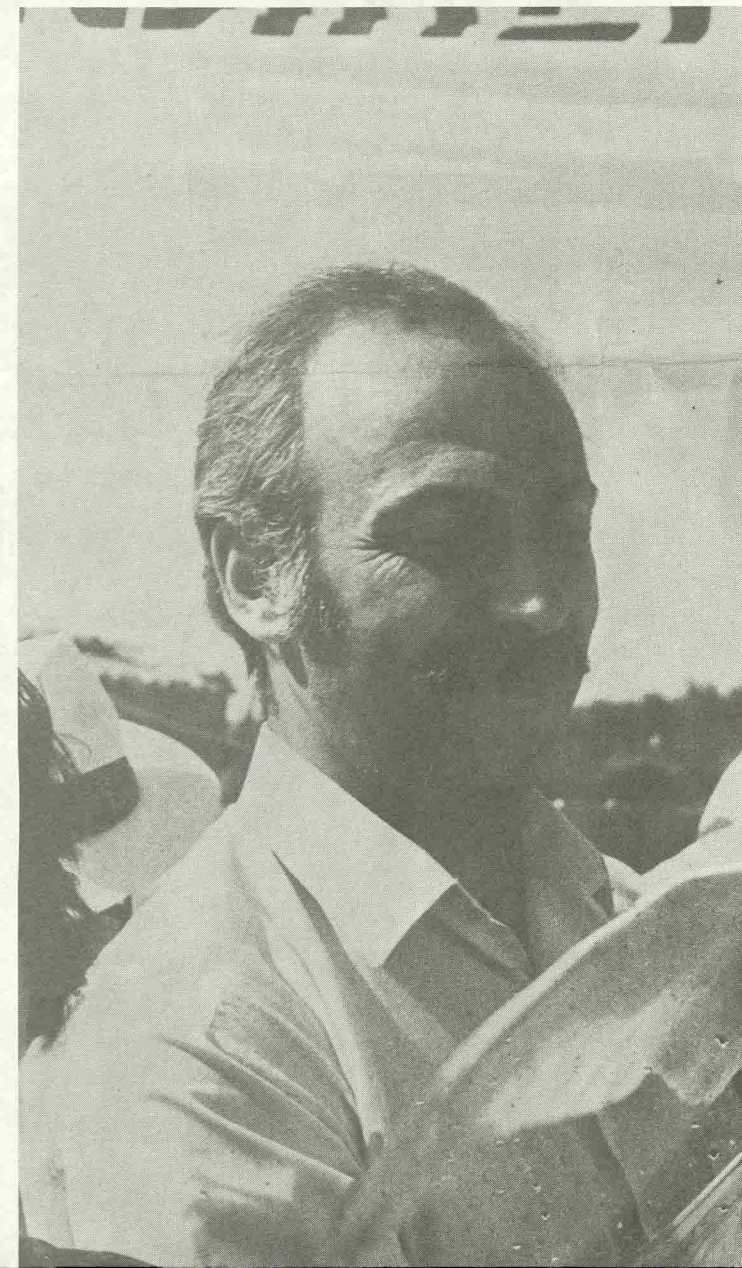
The slogans of the Marchers were:

- for Peace and Disarmament
- for the liquidation of the british military bases and the american monitoring stations on Cyprus,
- for the withdrawal of the turkish occupation troops and the complete demilitarisation of Cyprus,
- against the deployment of the Pershing 2 and Cruis US missiles in Europe and for nuclear disarmament.

The Resolution adopted by the Marchers demands:

- an end to the arms race
- banning of nuclear weapons and all weapons of mass destruction
- diminishing of armament leading to general and complete disarmament
- nuclear free zones and transformation of Mediterranean into a sea of peace without foreign fleet, troops and bases.

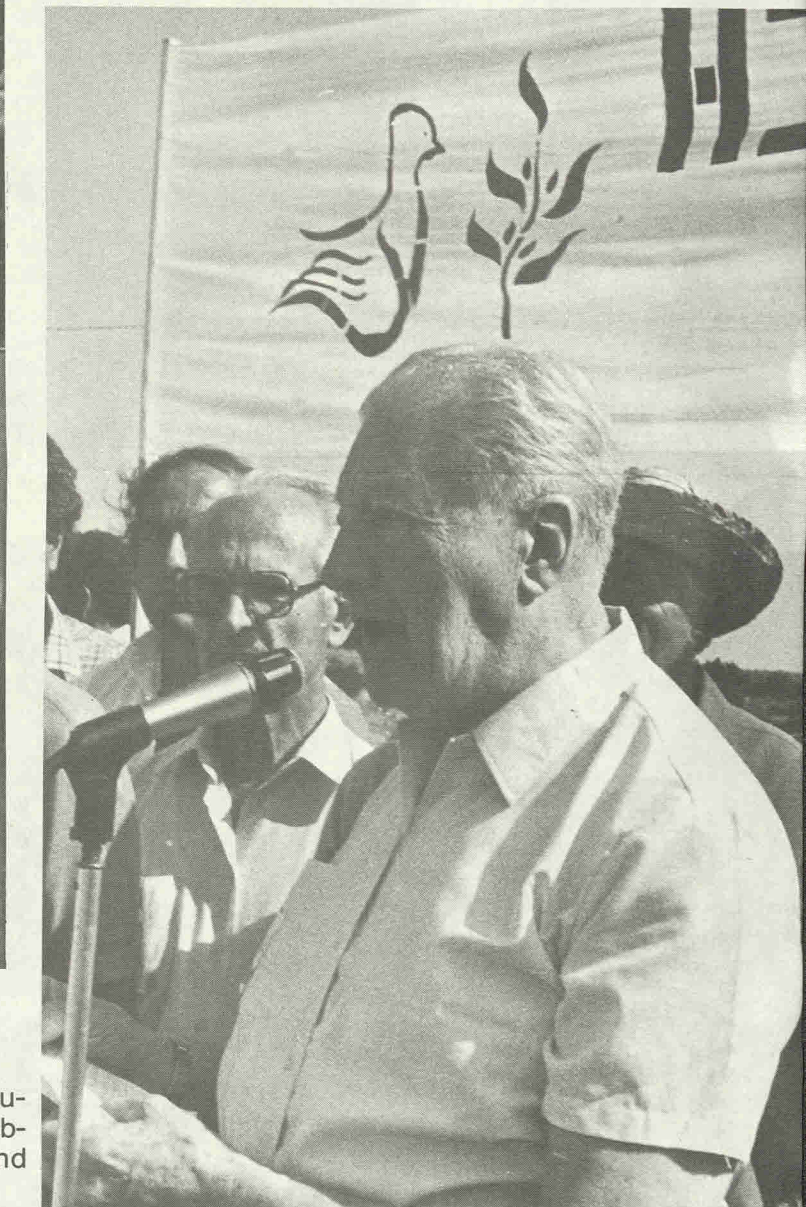

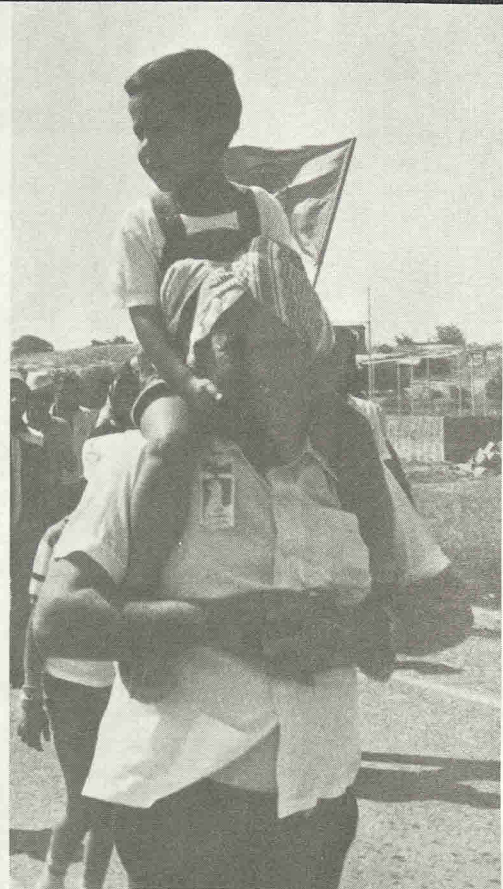
