QUEEN ANNE IN THE HOUSE OF LORDS

Painted c. 1708-14 by Peter Tillemans

The Queen is seated on the throne in the Parliament Chamber, the Old House of Lords Chamber from medieval times until 1801. She is attended by her ladies, Officers of State, Heralds and pages, with the House in session before her.

The tapestries around the Chamber depict the defeat of the Spanish Armada in 1588. Commissioned by Lord Howard and designed by Cornelius Vroom of Haarlem, they hung in Arundel House until 1616, when they were bought by King James I and VI and displayed in the Old House of Lords. They were later moved to the Court of Requests, which was used as the Lords Chamber from 1801 onwards, following the Union with Ireland. They were destroyed in the fire of 1834, together with much of the ancient Palace.
