There is a general desire of the friends in Ankara who are organised in AKÖK (Cypriots' Education and Culture Organisation). Our friends are sure that they have a right world view, but they say that they don't have enough idea about the thesis and the solutions that AKEL puts forward on Cyprus. They add that they don't know much about the past of the Party. Another subject under discuss is the "National Problem". My request from you is to send us the publications of the Party, if it is possible. And also I want you to write me about the situation at South and what ~~to~~ AKEL thinks about the North.

With the hope that the new year will be a forward step on the unity of Turk and Greek workers.
